AQUATIC PESTICIDE IN USE

Due to aquatic herbicide use in Burr Pond with SePRO ProcellaCOR EC (active ingredient florpyrauxifen-benzyl), authorized under Aquatic Nuisance Control Permit #2769-ANC-C, the following advisory water use recommendations are in effect for the entire lake and outlet stream.

LAKE WATER ADVISORY USE RECOMMENDATIONS

- It is recommended there be NO USE of Burr Pond waters and water from the outlet stream FOR ANY PURPOSE including boating, fishing, swimming, domestic (household) use or irrigation, the day of treatment on:

Tuesday, July 9, 2024, beginning at 9 am

- It is recommended swimming/wading, boating, fishing and domestic (household) use to resume on:

Wednesday, July 10, 2024, beginning at 9 am

- It is recommended USE of water from Burr Pond FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES including for watering lawns, trees, or other plants may resume on:

Tuesday, July 16, 2024, beginning at 9 am or earlier based on sampling results, please refer to the website below for results

Bottled water is available upon request by the Burr Pond Association (contact information below) to any person restricted from using its domestic water supply for drinking or food or drink preparation. Any person who chooses to ignore these use advisories does so at their own risk.
